GUIDELINES FOR BAPTISM

- 1. Parents who want to baptize their children at Holy Family Parish have to schedule an appointment with the priest and bring these guidelines
- 2. Parents should ask for their child's Baptism or, at least, consent their child to be baptized and be raised Catholic.
- 3. Parents must live within the boundaries of Holy Family Parish, which includes the mission churches of Dolores, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, Santuario de Chimayo, San Buenaventura Chapel, Santo Domingo de Cundiyo, San Isidro y Sagrado Corazón de Río Chiquito, San Antonio de Cordova, Ntra. Sra. del Rosario de Truchas, Santo Tomás de Ojo Sarco, San José de las Trampas, San Miguel del Valle.
- **4.** In the Archdiocese of Santa Fe, at least one of the names given to the baptized must be a saint's name.
- **5.** Parents that are not Holy Family parishioners must obtain written permission from their Parish.
- **6.** Pre-baptismal instructions are required.

GODPARENTS

Godparents must qualify to be Sponsors for Baptism, as follows:

- **1.** Be registered in their Parish. They must bring a *sponsor certificate* from their Parish.
- **2.** Be full participants in the life of the Church through the reception of the Sacraments, i.e., Baptism, Holy Eucharist, Penance, and Confirmation.
- **3.** If married, they must be married according to the faith they professed.
- **4.** Be at least 16 years of age.

A meeting will be held with the Parents and Godparents before the Baptismal ceremony to deliver some instructions on the:

Sacraments • Catholic Faith • The Baptismal Rite

Dedication to the Lord of the newly baptized babies and presentation to the congregation of Holy Family Parish will take place **on the Sunday following the Baptism**. Parents will receive the Baptismal Certificate during this Presentation.


Fee: \$ 25 for registered parishioners

To be paid at the Parish Office. A receipt will be issued.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A REGISTERED PARISHIONER?

- 1. You have to reside within Holy Family Parish boundaries, including Chimayo, and the mission communities of El Valle, Las Trampas, Ojo Sarco, Truchas, Cordova, Cundiyo, Rio Chiquito.
- 2. Share your time, talent, and treasure to build a vibrant and active parish community. Without you, our parish life is diminished.
- 3. Members who receive their monthly offering envelopes by mail and support the Parish are Registered Parishioners. The office maintains a record of all contributions available upon request. Suppose you live in one of the areas listed above and are not receiving your envelopes. In that case, the Parish office has no record of your registration. Please, come into the office to register.
- 4. Do not wait until you or your children need to receive a sacrament before you come to register. The time to plan for your baby's Baptism, for instance, is before the baby is born. Come into the office and inquire about the steps to take. Choose the Godparents following the requirements. Call the office if you have any questions (351-4360).
- 5. If you are 18 years or older, you are an adult and need to register on your own, unless you are a full-time student residing with your parents.
